

How to clean up your infected PC (for free)

(and keep it clean)

- 1) Download, install, update and run MalwareBytes' Anti-Malware at http://www.malwarebytes.org/products/malwarebytes_free(free)
- 2) If your current Antivirus program is asking for money for new definitions, uninstall it and download, install, update and run Microsoft Security Essentials <http://windows.microsoft.com/en-US/windows/products/security-essentials>
- 3) Visit Microsoft Update now <http://update.microsoft.com/windowsupdate> and get all critical updates.
- 4) If you have Limewire, Kazaa, Bearshare, Morpheus, iMesh or the like uninstall them because if you don't you'll probably re-infect yourself.
- 5) From time to time, open MalwareBytes' Anti-Malware update it and scan your PC again. MSE will scan automatically.
- 6) Update the Java used by your web browser to the latest version (read install carefully and uncheck any boxes asking to install an extra toolbar or program) <http://www.java.com/en/download/>
- 7) Update the Adobe Reader to the latest version http://www.adobe.com/go/EN_US-H-GET-READER
- 8) Update the Adobe Flash Player used by your web browser to the latest version http://www.adobe.com/go/EN_US-H-GET-FLASH
